1. **What is CMS?**

A Content Management System is software that keeps track of every piece of content on your Web site, much like your local public library keeps track of books and stores them. Content can be simple text, photos, music, video, documents, or just about anything you can think of. All of these are done dynamically!

1. **When should I choose to use CMS?**

CMS should be used when a website is fully dynamic: contents being added frequently. Content may be any type of media files or text. CMS does not require web-developing/programming skills.

1. What are the advantages of having a CMS website?

By having a CMS website, the back-end user (administrator) has easy access to the website. Simply via a web browser you can access your website and start doing modifications. The administrator can create sections, categories articles and other modules. Best of all, it does not require any developing skills to do all these!

1. How can I have an ecommerce website to sell products online via paypal?

First you need to have a Content Management System (CMS website) in order to manage your products properly. Second, we recommend you to get SSL (Secure Socket Layer) from your hosting company to increase your website's security (some hosting companies include in their hosting plans with no extra charge). It is not necessary to have SSL in order for you [ecommerce](#) website to work, but it is highly recommended.
